3. What has Matthew's contrast of Jesus' prayerfulness and the disciples' sleepiness got to teach us in our own discipleship journeys? Consider the contrast of how Jesus and the disciples respond to all that takes place after the garden.

4. Chris mentioned how this scene has a unique contribution to make to our understanding of Jesus, of his love for us and the costliness of the cross to him. How has thinking and meditating on this scene, in the words of Paul's prayer to the Philippians, made 'your love abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight'?

5. Where have you been challenged to say to God, 'Yet not as I will, but as you will'?
